THE PUBLIC ARE INVITED TO THE BOXGROVE ELECTORS' MEETING

- 1. This meeting is for the electors of Boxgrove. The Parish council will be present to answer any questions or listen to any comments.
 - Mr Paul Addison had been contacted by a resident of Crockerhill to ask about the plans that had been proposed some years ago to render Crockerhill more cohesive. At the time it had been suggested that CIL money should be used for this. As the garage site begins to be less intrusive this could perhaps be reviewed.
 - Cllr Tynan and Mr Addison will be part if the group of volunteers checking on the state of the windmill and once the sails are refitted (Summer 2026) will turn the sails at regular intervals. Mr Addison had checked the windmill before the meeting and complimented the Langmead family on the wildflower planting that has made the site tidier and more attractive. He thought that it also made the area safer.
 - A member of the public asked what was the projected role of Parish Council's after devolution? Cllr Potter said that for the moment that is an unknown quantity. Cllr Lovejoy said that based on areas that had already devolved the role of the Parish Council will stay about the same, but no one really knew for the moment.
